Reading: We will be exploring the difference between nonfiction and fiction texts. We will be more closely examining the elements of fiction text this week. We will also begin working on our RADD DUDE work. In this, students will be invited to read a passage and then answer a RADD DUDE question. (Restate, Answer, Detail, Detail. Did You Say Enough?)

Math: We will be continuing to work on place value to the 10,000 as well as comparing and ordering numbers to the 10,000. We will continue to work in a "Math Workshop" small group format. Students will be introduced to RIPS homework this week.

ELA/Writing: We will be reviewing contractions. We will also continue writing using transition words.

Science/SS: We will be examining our crystals and doing scratch tests on rocks!
