Reading: We will be exploring nonfiction texts in reading this week. We will talk about the different elements of a nonfiction text and go on a nonfiction scavenger hunt.

Math: We have been working hard on comparing and ordering numbers up to the 10,000. Students have been doing great! This week we will be focusing on rounding numbers to the ten and hundred. I will introduce rounding by visualizing a number line. Toward the end of the week, I will teach students a "rounding rap" to help them follow the steps of rounding.

ELA/Writing: This is a grammar review week. We will be reviewing common and proper nouns, verbs, and verb tenses. We will have a grammar quiz on Friday. In writing, we will be looking at the process of taking a personal narrative from a graphic organizer to a final paper.

Science/SS: We loved having Dr. Elliott from USI last week! This week we will be conducting calcite tests!
